

Your health and safety are our top priority. While we've been apart, our staff and volunteers have been working hard to prepare to welcome you back. In collaboration with the Arts Council of Indianapolis and public health officials, we have implemented new policies and procedures to ensure a safe visit for you.

Please read these guidelines carefully as you plan your visit:

- Advance tickets are required for all visitors including members and donors. Groups of up to 6 may reserve a tour time beginning at the top of the hour preferably through the website.
- Cleaning will be done hourly. We appreciate you understanding the need for this and it should not affect your visit with us.
- Everyone is expected to follow social distancing requirements.
- Face masks are required for all visitors ages 2 and older.
- Bring your credit or debit card for purchases
- Hand washing is encouraged and hand sanitizer stations are provided throughout the building.
- Please refrain from touching displays as much as possible.
- If you are not feeling well, please stay home. We will gladly exchange your ticket for a day when you feel better!

Here's what you can expect from us:

- Limited capacity: We are allowing groups of up to 6 in to tour at the top of the hour. Preregistering is required for a time slot.
- Enhanced cleaning: New cleaning protocols include frequent disinfecting of all high-touch surfaces.
- Access to cleaning supplies: We have positioned hand sanitizing stations throughout the museum and placed sanitizing wipes in all exhibit areas.
- Staff and Volunteer health checks: All staff, volunteers, and contractors will have their temperature taken upon entry to the museum and will be required to wear a mask at all times.
